## **2019 Course rules:**

Dress code for men: must have a collared shirt

All players must have soft spikes or tennis shoes and their own set of clubs.

You must be 16 or older with a valid driver's license to rent or operate a golf cart on the course.

## Foursome Rule – May 1 – Labor Day:

Friday – Sunday

Threesomes allowed, foursomes preferred no other group configurations permitted until after 3:00.

Only two golf carts per group

Monday – Thursday

We encourage players to join up whenever possible. Groups larger than four must have permission from the Pro Shop.

## <u>Junior Rule – June 1 – Labor Day:</u>

Junior golfers under 18 who do not have an established USGA handicap of 25 or less need to meet with the Pro to go over the rules of golf and course rules.

All players should check in the Pro Shop before teeing off to see if there are any special rules or any outings / times scheduled for that day. All play starts on hole #1 unless permission from the Pro Shop.

Please help us keep our course the best it can be by fixing ball marks, replacing divots, raking traps, following all cart signs and making sure garbage gets in the trash cans.

If you're healthy enough to play golf then you're healthy enough to fix your ball marks.

We expect a round of golf to take no more than 4 hours, let faster paced groups play through.

Your place on the golf course is behind the group in front of you not in front of the group behind you.

We hope you enjoy your round of golf and come back again.
